### Curriculum Vitae

Born on August 1, 1942 in Zagreb. Graduated from the High school in Zagreb. Graduated from the Faculty of Law. Married, lives in Zagreb.

Worked as an independent administrative Referent and Counselor in the Zagreb Center for Social Work from 1972. until 1974., then as the Counselor and Secretary of the Executive Committee of the Assembly of the municipality of Maksimir from 1975. until 1982. From 1982. until 1991. Worked as the Head of the Department and as the Assistant and Deputy of the General Secretary in the Town Secretariat for Administration and Justice.

From the beginning of April 1992. Worked as the Counselor in the office of the President of the Republic of Croatia and as the Deputy of the Head of the Office. From April 1992. Worked as the Deputy to the Minister of Justice and Administration. On the first of September designated as the Secretary of the Croatian Government and again designated to the same duty on the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 1993.

From the 1<sup>st</sup> of June, 1993 until 10<sup>th</sup> of July 1994. was the Member of the Croatian Government and the Minister of Administration. He was appointed for the judge of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia and from the 11<sup>th</sup> of July 1994 until 11<sup>th</sup> of July 2002 worked as the Judge. Appointed for the Vice President of the Constitutional Court for two times in that period, in 1998 and 2000.

He published numerous professional articles in the field of human rights, administration and local self-administration. Author and Associate on many research and law projects in those fields.

Appointed for the Ombudsman on the 1<sup>st</sup> of December 2004.
