- I was born on 1.may.1980. in city of Osijek, where I finished my elementary school and high school (Gymnassium).
- From 1999.- 2004. I studied on Philosophical University of Society of Jesus in city of Zagreb. On this university I finished Philosophy and Religious culture. My degree work was on T.G. Masaryks problem on religion as ethical issues. With this degree work I achieved my title as Professor of Philosophy and Religious culture.
- My average score on university was: 4 (very good).
- During my studies I was an editor of student magazine named "FiR" (Philosophy and Religion).
- I am permanent co - operator and activ member of Croatian Helsinki Committee for Human Rights in Zagreb and Vukovar from 1999. till now and also a member and co - operator of Centre for "Non-Violence and Peace" in Osijek.
- I served my civil service for 8 months in Croatian Helsinki Committee for Human Rights in their offices in Vukovar and Zagreb, where for 6 months I was also manager of the field office in Vukovar.
- I published an article on philosophy of T.G. Masaryk in expert philosophical magazine "Prolegomena", Zagreb.
- I was attending several summer schools on human rights, organized by Croatian Helsinki Committee for Human rights (rights of homosexual Communities, social rights and labor rights, rights of minorities).
- I was involved in disabling visa regime between Serbia and Croatia, in cooperation with NGO's from Novi Sad and Belgrade (Citizen Pact and Women in Black).

- As Croatian citizen I speak Croatian language as my mother language and Slovak language as my second mother language. From foreign languages I fluently speak English, Czech and German little bit less fluently.
